

Using mindfulness and gentle, easy movements your eyes can heal and your vision improve. Many participants find that along with improving vision balance and a sense of safety while walking improves, old aches and pains in the eyes, neck and back disappear and seeing becomes delight.

David Webber, GCFP lost his eyesight suddenly in 1996 at the age of 43 due to a severe inflammatory eye condition (uveitis) and was declared legally blind. He regained his vision by working with the principles of the Feldenkrais Method. Based on his healing experience, he has been teaching Seeing Clearly Workshops in North America and Europe for the last fifteen years.
